On the pages noted are items that back our claims of corrupt conduct in regard to this matter.

Page 24. John Humphries (the sole practicing Hydraulics Engineer at the time) recognizes the wrong in the proposed system.

He describes it as "INIQUITOUS."

John Humphries - stated that placing a charge on size of meter is iniquitous as fire hose reel system may force businesses to put in a larger meter. Small businesses alone could have charges increased by over \$2,000.

Councilor Kath Knowles recognizes the probable effect on business viability

Cr Knowles - expressed concern at possible increases of sewer charges to businesses under user pays as may effect viability of some businesses.

These observations made almost 2 years before Council implemented the Sewer Access Charge are the same as can be claimed at the date of compiling this material being 5/10/2011
